

## Learning for Life Financial Support

The Smith Family's *Learning for Life* program recognises that some children need extra support to stay at school and go on to further studies or a job to reach their potential. The *Learning for Life* scholarship helps create better futures for children by providing:

Financial assistance; support from a *Learning for Life* Program Coordinator and access to Smith Family educational programs to help children get the most out of their school years. A biannual payment is made to families to help them cover education-related expenses, such as books, uniforms, camps and excursions. The funds are used to help students participate in activities that are core to the educational development of all young people. School Banking Day is every Tuesday. We offer school Banking for Commonwealth Bank and Beyond Bank. Please contact the Front Office for more information. Thank you.



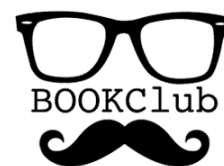
## Book Fair

Feeling – muscles (feet)

- Sitting down, just rest your feet flat on the floor (demonstrate)
- Now stretch your toes as wide apart as possible and hold them tense like that for 30 seconds
- Now curl your toes under and hold them curled for 30 seconds.
- Rest them back again, now they should be relaxed
- Where could you feel your muscles when your toes were stretched and when they were curled?

Image – feet, toes relaxed  
Image – feet with toes stretched out  
Image – feet with toes curled under  
Image – feet one stretched, one curled with big question mark

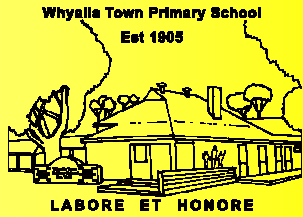
