The new title best reflects the role and work of these positions and clearly delineates the service from expectations of a professional counselling and therapeutic service to students and families.

Student wellbeing leaders work in partnership with learners, parents and caregivers, educators and the broader community to promote wellbeing and to optimise student learning.

The student wellbeing service offers:

- support to encourage attendance, behaviour and learning at school
- support help manage relationships with family, teachers and peers
- support to manage issues
- crisis responses
- advice, support and referral to therapeutic services (eg CAMHS, Youth Mental Health) and student support service
